**Dave Bull Trophy awarded at Lightning Regatta**

The Caz-One-Day regatta was held on September 26, hosted by the Willow Bank Yacht Club Lightning fleet. Sailors from Central New York participated. Conditions were perfect, sunshine and winds of 7 to 12. Winner was Federico Meira of Cazenovia, second was Jack Jones from Henderson, third was Dick Tuttle of Cazenovia and fourth was Skylar Munger from Rochester.

This annual regatta was started in 1992 by Dave Bull. He set up the special race course, designed the graphics, wrote the instructions and he made the trophies. He even called the gathering of skippers by blowing his famous conch horn. Dave was an active racer in the fleet. Later in life he was race chair for all the special Lightning races.

Dave died last year. In his memory the fleet has dedicated the winner's trophy in his name. When Federico Meira was awarded the trophy he commented, "We all remember our special times with Dave. He was our friend." It was especially fitting that Federico was the first winner of this trophy, as he was sailing Dave Bull's former boat.
