1. **RULES:** The regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2010, the International Lightning Class District Championship Rules, the Notice of Race (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions.

2. **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** Lightning Fleet #187, Sheboygan Yacht Club, Sheboygan, Wisconsin.

3. **ADVERTISING:** This regatta is designated Category A in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code).

4. **ELIGIBILITY:** This regatta is open to boats and crews as described in Article V and VI of the Class Rules. Eligible boats may register in advance by completing the attached entry form and sending it with the \$60.00 entry fee to:

5. **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

Saturday, June 26 - 0800 to 0930 Check in and registration  
0930 to 1000 Competitors meeting  
1100 Warning signal for the first race

Sunday, June 27 - 0930 Warning signal for the first race of the day  
Following completion of a race the warning signal for succeeding races will be made as soon as possible.  
On Sunday, June 27 no warning signal will be made after 1300.  
Closing ceremonies and awards.

6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** SI's will be available at the time of check-in and will be posted on the official notice board on the dock shack at the Sheboygan Yacht Club. Hard copies will be available for all skippers.

7. **RACING AREA:** The racing area will be on Lake Michigan east of the Sheboygan Yacht Club.

8. **MEASUREMENT:** Valid certificates as required by Class Rules must be presented. Boats may be weighed voluntarily prior to racing.

9. **SAFETY:** All boats are expected to comply with the safety equipment as specified by the ILCA. Skippers are reminded of the necessity of carrying 50 feet of 3/8inch line.

10. **DISCLAIMER:** The Sheboygan Yacht Club, its members, employees, and/or agents will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury that may occur to persons or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any competing yacht in any way. Competitors' attention is drawn to RRS fundamental Rule Part 1.
