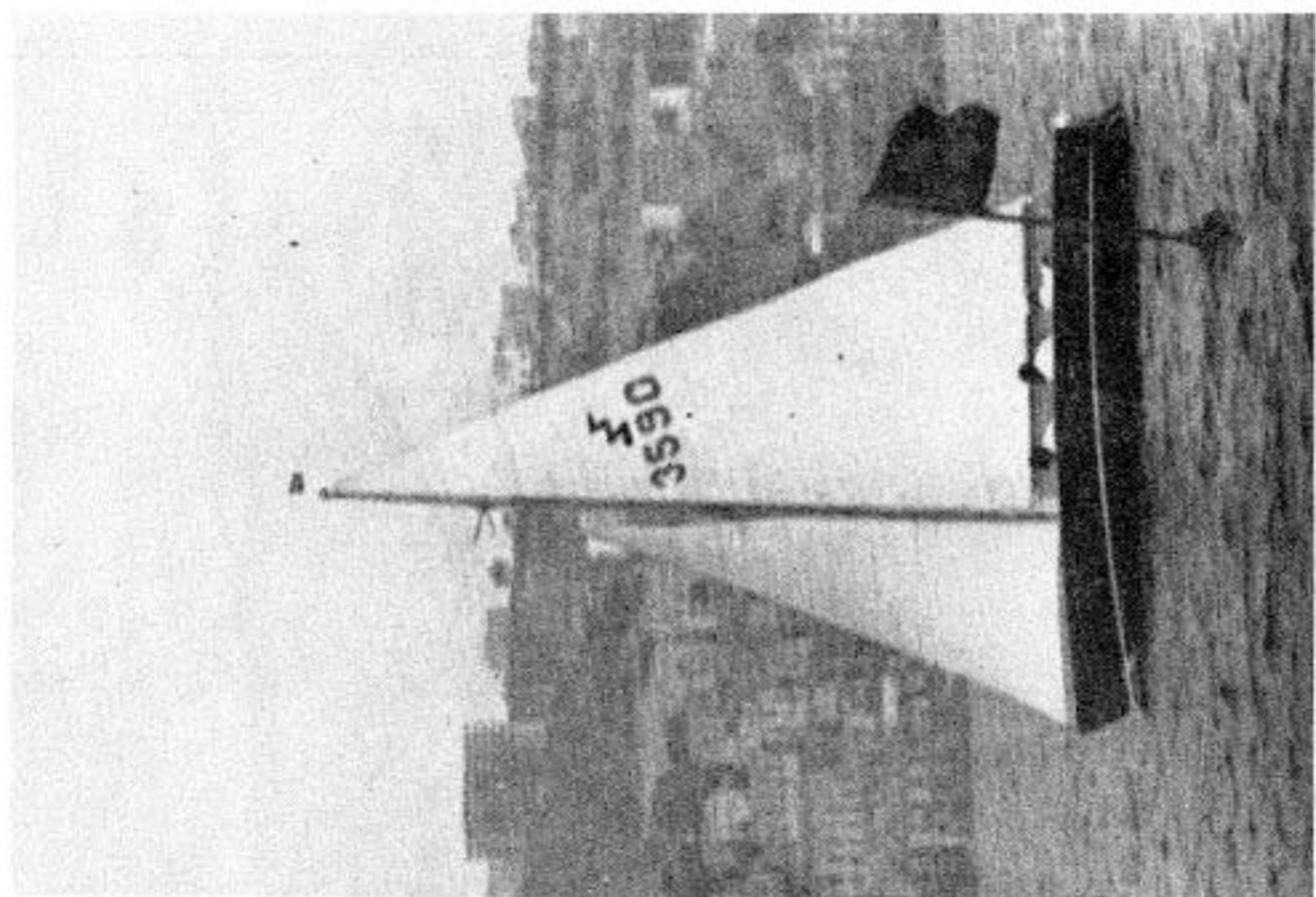

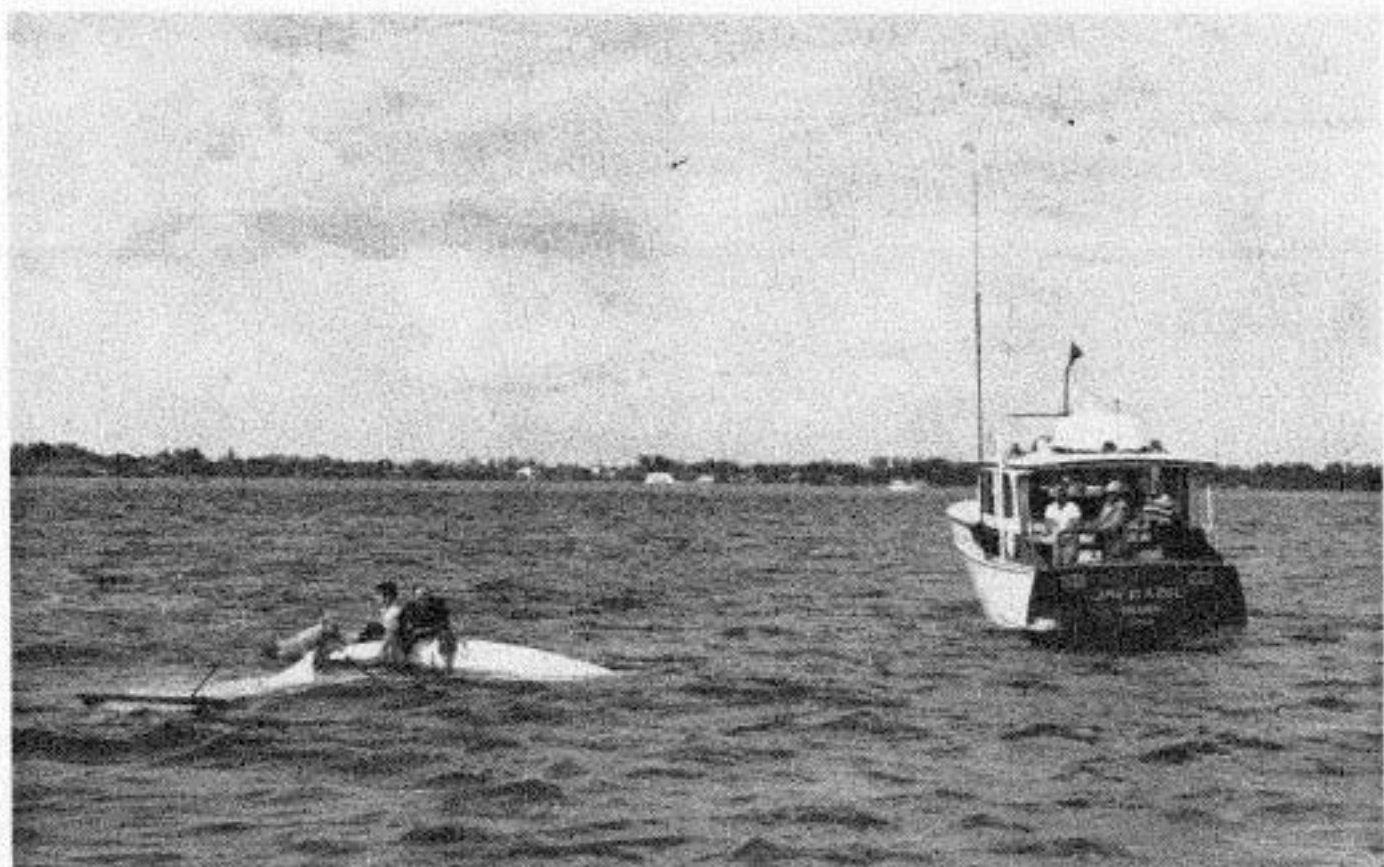

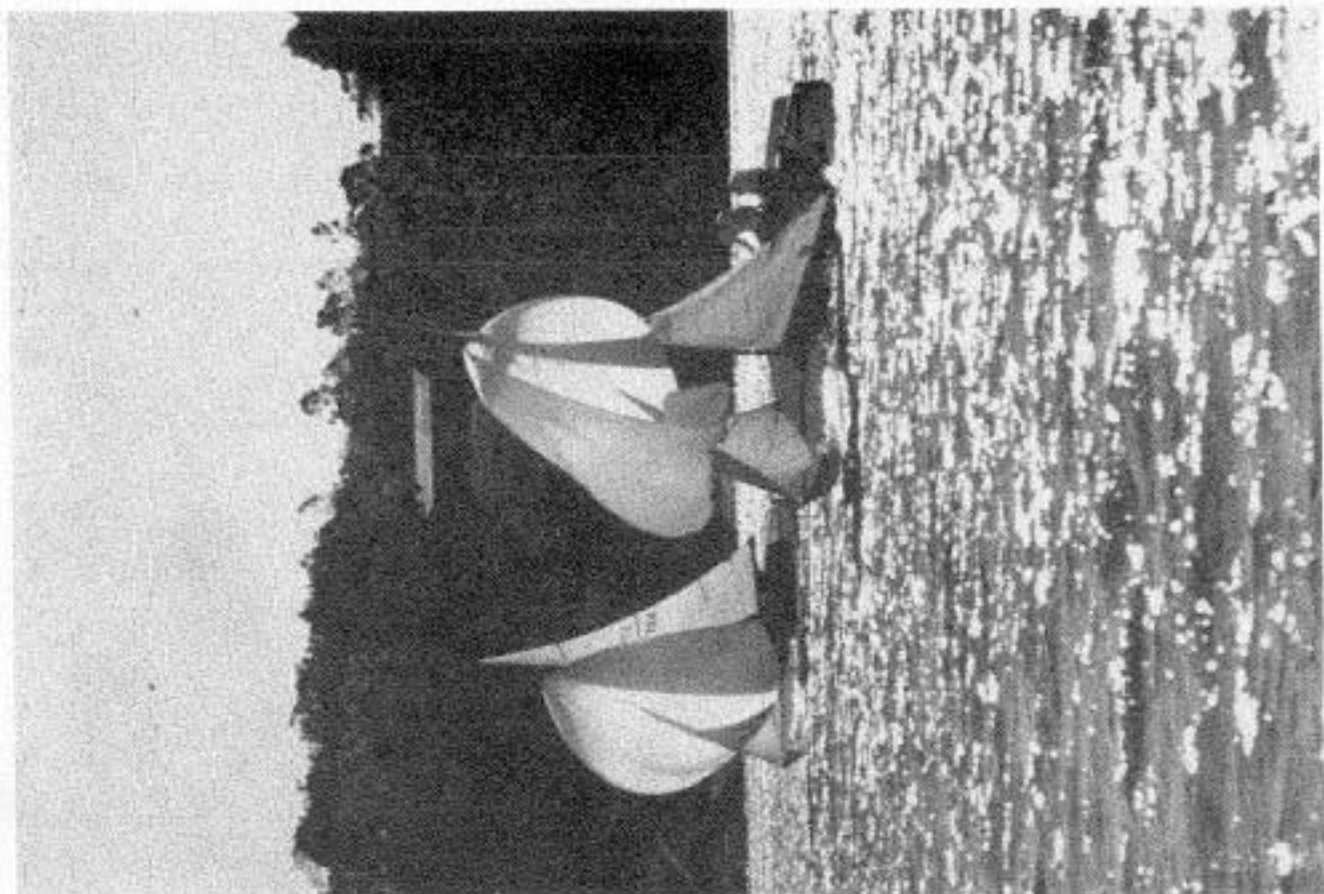

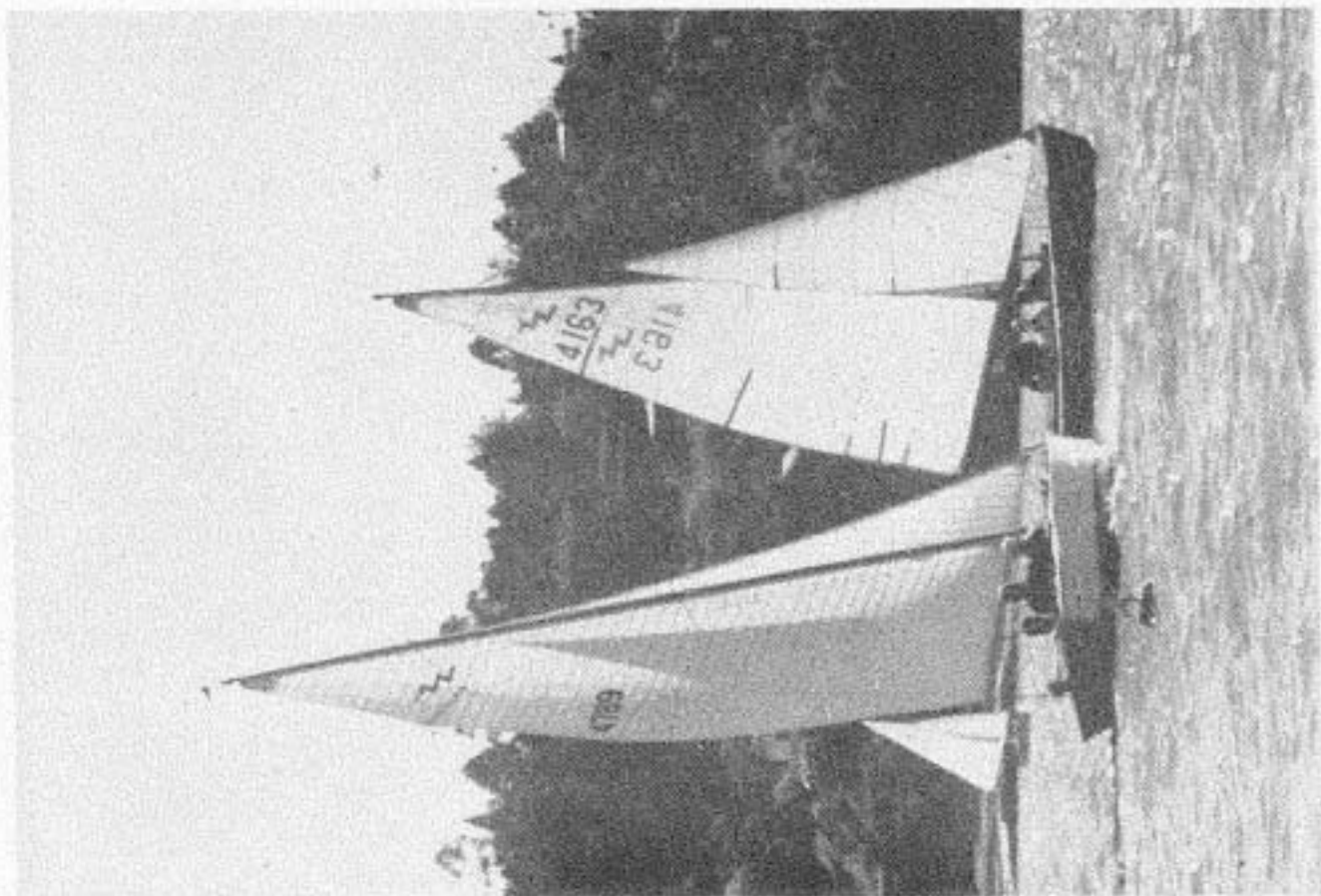

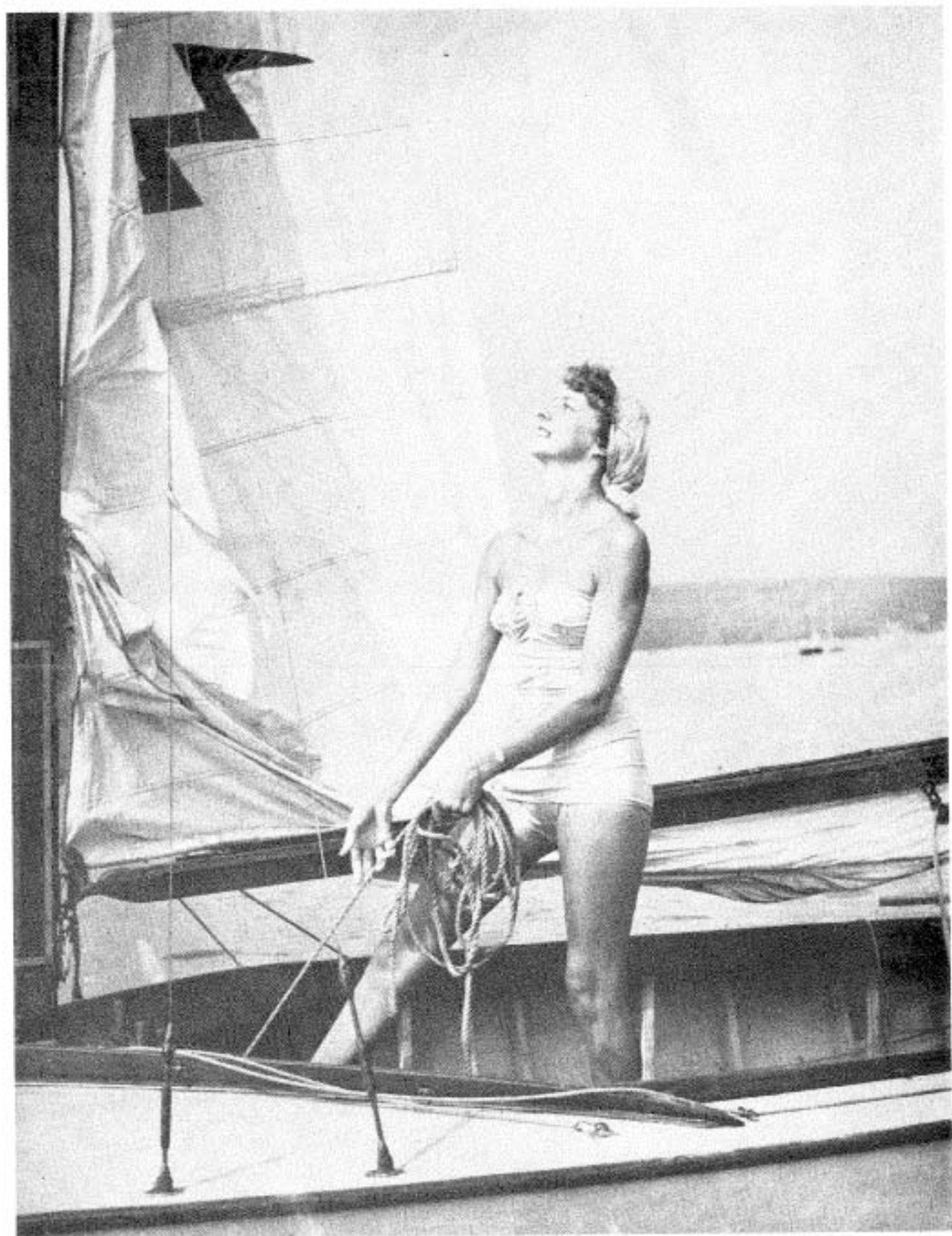
Start of the first race of the Ohio-Indiana District Regatta of 1952



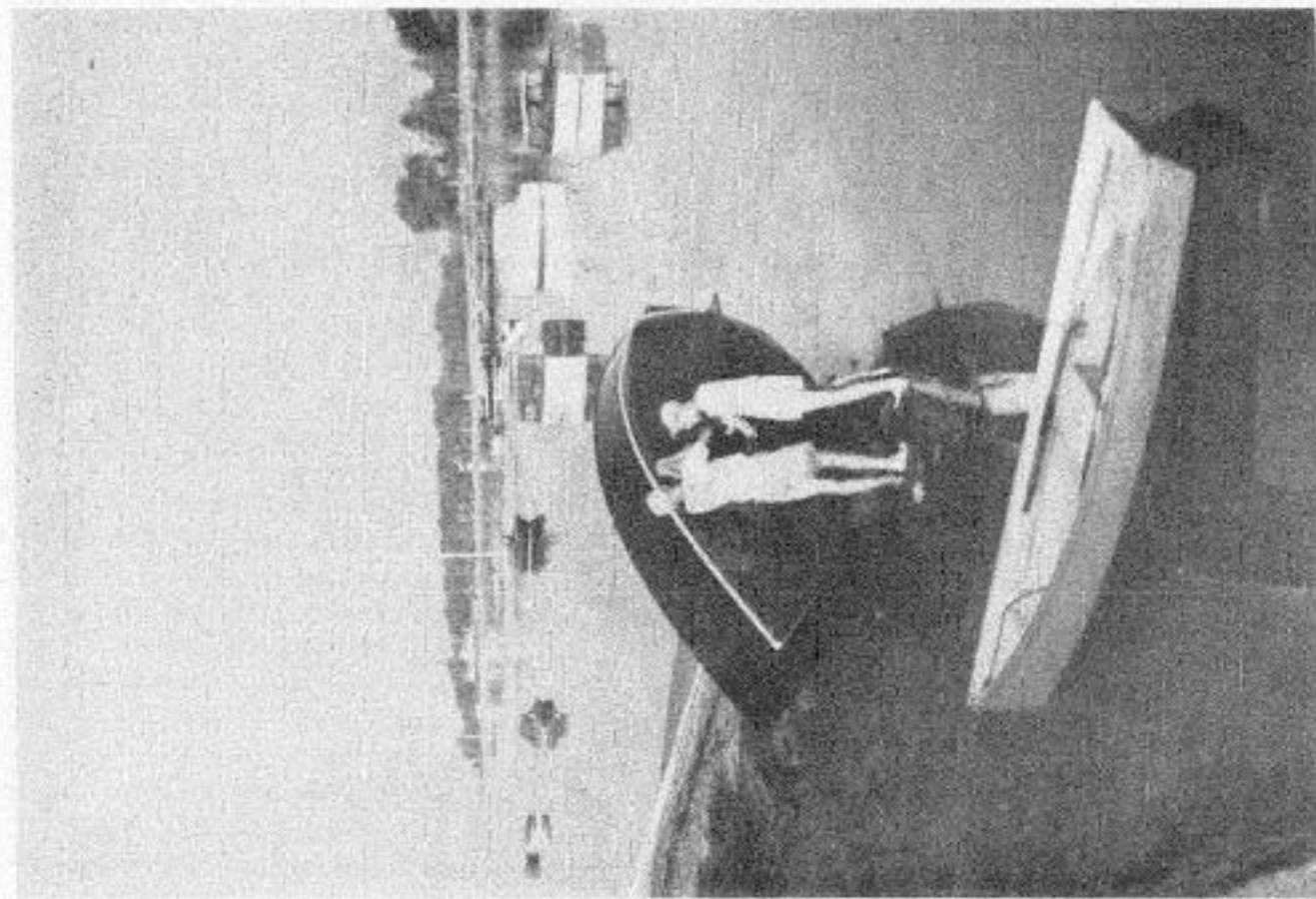

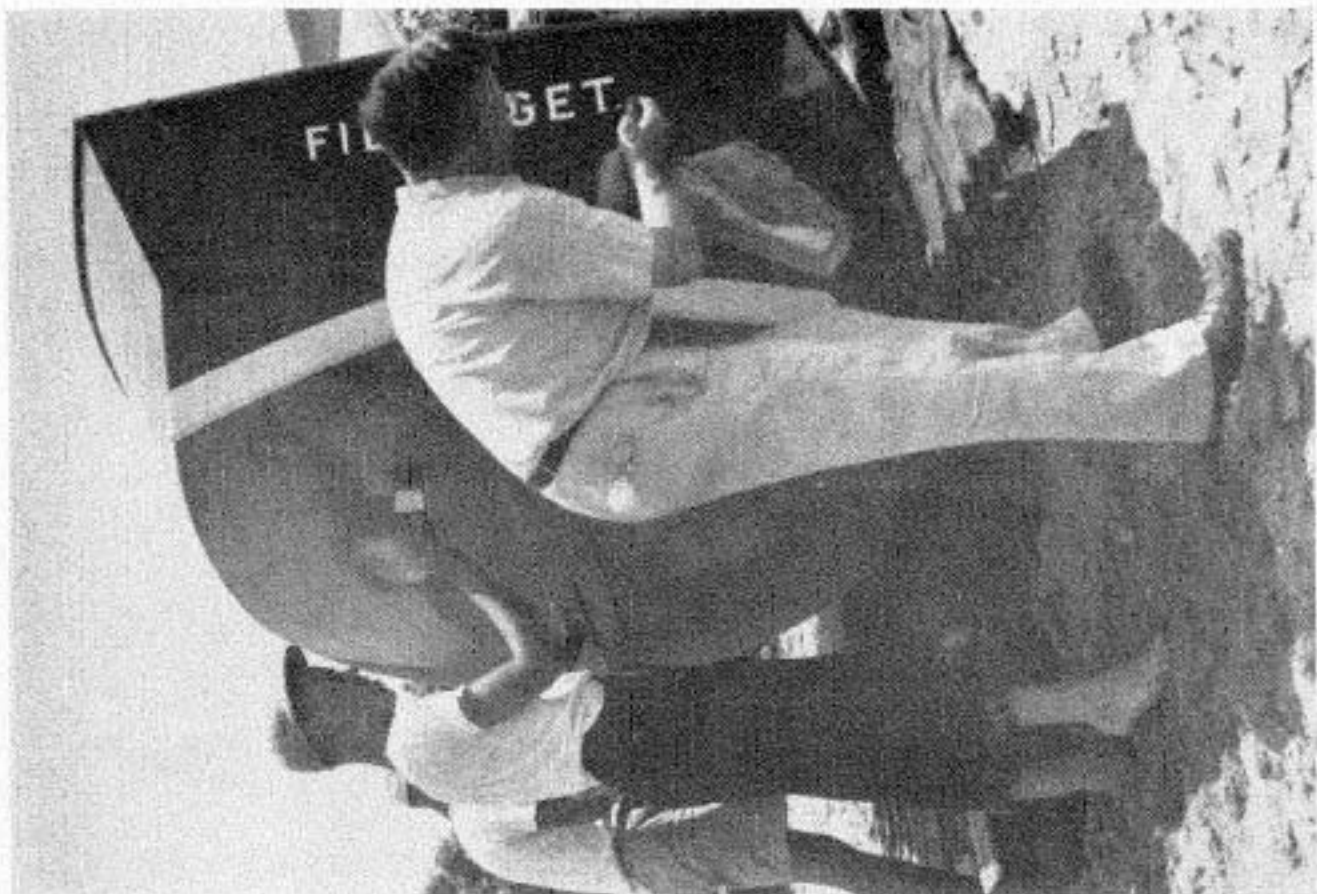

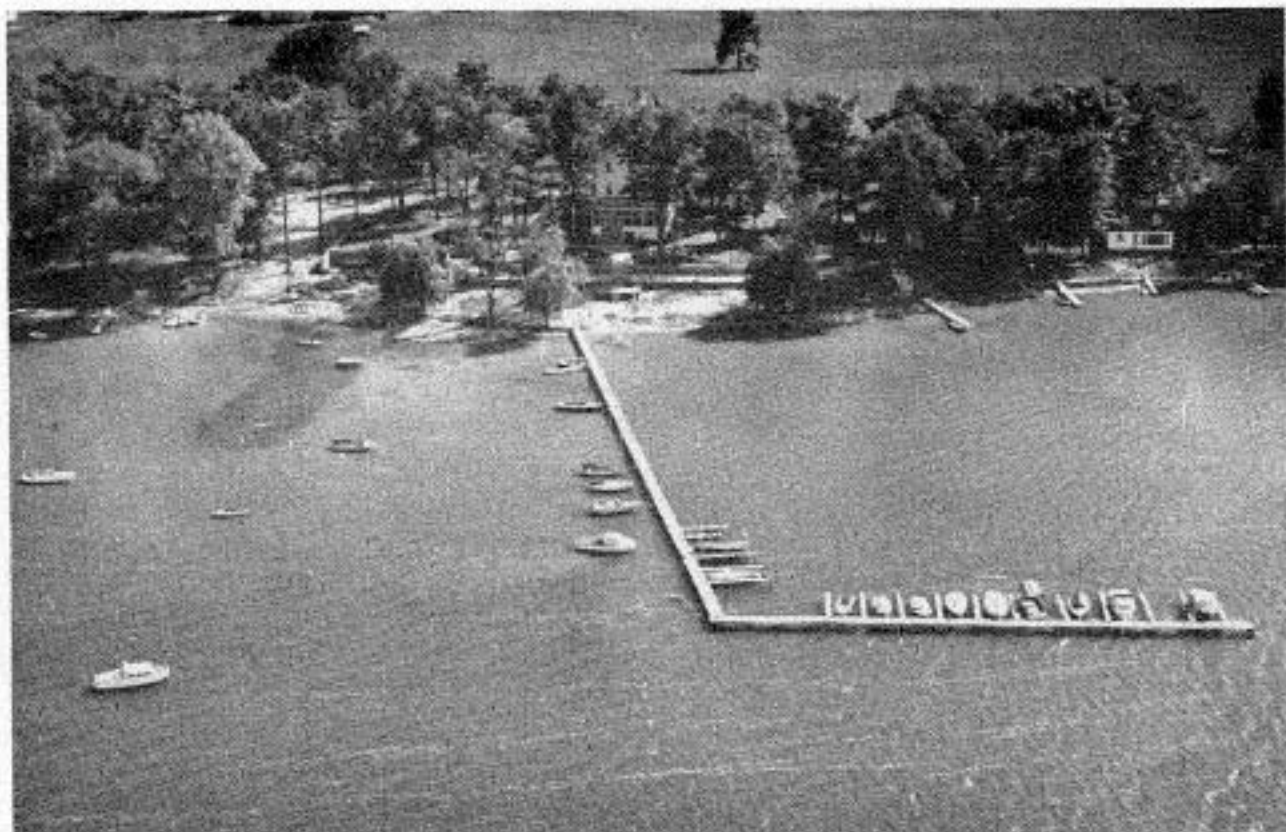
