As he did with hundreds of other young sailors, he taught me by example that the most important part of racing sailboats, and real life, was the value of sportsmanship.
This year at CYC's annual sailing banquet, the "John W. Mueller Memorial Trophy" will be presented for the first time (and then annually) to the sailor who comes closest to achieving the monumental standards of yacht racing sportsmanship which Papa John has left us. I can think of no better tribute to this great man."

"John, long a Lightning innovator, was delighted when a partially destroyed hull turned up at the boat shop. Now he had a Lightning with which he could try out many of his latest ideas.

So, off I went to the races with a 550 lb , boat without a skeg, with a high floor, no centerboard trunk (spray drained through the slot in the floor), an aluminum daggerboard which could be moved fore and aft to balance the helm, and a not yet approved oval mast and boom.

Upon my return, I told him about the problems encountered at the regatta, and the weird stares of competitors. He thought for a long time. Finally, with a sly grin he conceded, "Maybe a Lightning does need a skeg."
