An Interview with Mike Huffman


## How did the program get started?

Mike: The idea of having a traveling coach, who could visit fleets and provide instruction at the appropriate level, is something I had been kicking around for a few years. In July of 1996 I attended the New England District
Championships ar Newburyport. A hurricane was blowing through that weekend and I got a chance to talk with Robert Clawson, a member of the home fleet. Robert's grandfather had set up a foundation and Robert felt that it might be willing to support an initiative to encourage youth sailing. I told him about this coaching idea and he invited me to apply for a grant. We were successful and received enough funding to take the next step - find a coach.
How did you manage to find Jon?
Mike: I posted an ad on the ICYRA (Intercollegiate Yacht Racing Association) webpage. We were lucky - Jon replied within a few days. We talked over the phone and I checked out his references. Jon is a US Sailing Level 2 certified instructor and has a lot of experience teaching junior racers. His personal strengths fit our job description well.

## Had Jon sailed Lightnings before?

Mike: Not really, Jon lives in Newport and he made plans to sail with Tim Healy a few times and then teamed up with Jon Schwartz at the Worlds. So he learned quickly. The intent wasn't to conduct a bunch of tuning seminars anyway.

## What was Jon's schedule like?

Mike: It was kind of put together on the run. I don't make any apologies for this because we just had to get started and then improve the program as it went along. 1 tried to identify fleets where Jon could have a big impact and then schedule nearby fleets as best we could. Travel expenses make up more than half of the cost of this program. Jon managed to visit 25 fleets plus the North Americans at North Cape and Crescent. With better scheduling, he could have hit 40 fleets easily.

## How much did the program cost?

Mike: Somewhere between $\$ 8,000$ and $\$ 10,000$, I never have received a final accounting. This was almost entirely funded by donations; $30 \%$ from the Harmon Foundation and the rest from other individuals, so other than taking some of Karen's time there was no impact on the class budget. Future funding remains a big concern.
How much did it cost the fleets?
Mike: Not much at all. The idea was that each fleet would house and feed the coach while he visited; a few fleets failed to grasp this at first. One future funding idea is to solicit donations from hosts with a suggested, but certainly not mandatory, contribution. We would prefer to keep this a Lightning Class program as opposed to one sponsored by a sailing-relared business.

## Didn't any of the Sailmakers help out?

Mike: Yes, Greg Fisher at North Sails Central had a couple shirts made up and he dug up a camcorder. Probably he helped most by providing Jon with some video footage of rolltacks and spinnaker work that Jon could use on land, often before hitting the water where the images would be fresh in everyone's mind. We need more of this stuff. Another individual donated another video camera to increase the chance that at least one would be operable. We talked about having the coach sell educational material such as the North U. One Design Course book but that didn't happen in 1997.
I should add that the Shore loft offered to help too and that we hope to take them up on it this year.
What about fleets outside the U.S.?
Mike: Canada shouldn't be much of a problem. The coach is an independent contractor; as such he is free to seek other jobs. As long as he doesn't get paid to coach in Canada or anywhere else for that matter there shouldn't be any serious impediments - other than travel expenses. Finland and Nigeria expressed interest in having the Coach visit with travel expenses paid by them - this should be pursued. In '97 it wasn't possible but we are an International Class and
we should get the coach everywhere we can.

## How did the Coach work out at the N.A.s?

Mike: I wasn't there but I have heard only good things. I really hope that someone will figure out how to make best use of the Coach and make some recommendations for 1998 and beyond. 1 do know that the Coach got many junior sailors interested in the junior NA's.

## Will there be a Coach in 1998?

Mike: We think so. The hiring process has begun; we can only hope that it goes as well this year. Jon Singsen is an excellent coach and we were extremely fortunate to have
him serve as our first coach. The Harmon Foundation has granted us more money but this is the last year they will do so. So we must figure out how to pay for some of this year as well as all of future years.
How can I request a visit by the Coach for my fleet?
Mike: Let the Class office know by phone, mail or internet with any specific event you have in mind or what days of the week are best (most available days are weekdays and weeknights). The program will be even more successful with better advance planning. -

When I first read about the Lightning Coach program in the Flashes, I became interested in the program, but it wasn't until I met Jon Singsen at the Worlds in Montreal that the possibility of holding a clinic became a reality. My main interest was to get more youths in our district involved in racing Lightnings. For the past seven years my son has had the privilege of racing Lightnings as a Junior. At the onset of his sailing, it was very apparent that the lightning was an excellent boat for juniors, but in our district there just has not been that many juniors racing. It was time to do something.
In the Rochester area, as in many other areas around the country, there are 100's of youth involved in the Optimist programs of the local sailing clubs. When they age out of the Optimist, what do they sail and where do they go? This is an untapped resource for new lightning sailors. But, how do you introduce them to the Lightning and how can you keep them coming back? With the Lightning Coach program, it is now possible to offer a free clinic to those youths who where aging out of the Optimist programs, as well as fostering more enthusiasm from the youth of our club. This approach was very well received by our club and Lightning Flect members who generously gave their time and the use of their boats. The Clinic was scheduled for a week after the Centrals, our district's multi-class regatta. This gave me an opportunity to advertise the event to the local sailing programs and as a result 1 received 18 responses. The final element, as always, would be the weather.
The Clinic, scheduled as an all day event, started with the North Sails-Fisher video, followed by a dry land
introduction to the Lightning. By the time the on-land training was over, the Northern Thermal had filled in on the bay with a steady 10 to 12 knot breeze. It was time to hit the water. This is where the expertise of Jon shined. With video camera in hand he video taped each boat, while coaching the crews on what to do. After an afternoon of sailing, the boats were put away and the video was reviewed. The outcome of this clinic was that one team was put together to sail the Junior NA's and many of the others were very interested in sailing again. The timing could have been better, because we failed to capitalize on getting the kids that took the clinic, back into to sailing in a Lightning. As the season came to an end I
kept thinking of how to improve this opportunity to attract youth into the Class. Two things keep coming to mind. One is to offer another (free) clinic and the second is to setup a program to allow these youth to sail the Lightning on a regular basis. Having a Lightning Class sponsored coach makes the clinic not only easy to setup, but provides a great advertising tool. Being able to make available for no charge just adds to the program. How many one-design classes can make this claim? I am certain that by having the program sponsored by the class along with a top notch instructor made this past year's program very successful, but to take full advantage requires that the program continue into the future. 1 can only hope that we as a class can find the funds to allow this highly successful program to continue. As I write this we are working on ideas to allow youth to sail on a regular basis.
