

Debbie Probst – Secretary

Sailing for me started very young, on our family Highlander and progressing through Optis, Sunfish and Lasers at Cowan Lake in Southwestern Ohio. The fierce competition and camaraderie amongst the juniors on Sunday afternoons was always the highlight of my week. My love for this sport and the people it attracts is deeply rooted in Cowan Lake Sailing Association and the incredible volunteers there.

Junior Sailing led to four years on the University of Michigan Sailing Team and meeting fellow Wolverine Jody Swanson. What followed has been twenty-five years (and counting!) of sitting next to Jody on J-24s, J-22s, and 470s. Bill has enjoyed being a part of the Executive Committee this year and hopes to continue to serve the Class as photographer and Chief Measurer in the years ahead.



Bill Faude – Executive Committee Member

I did not grow up in a Lightning family. I began sailing Lightnings in 1987 after finishing grad school and doing a somewhat formal review of affordable one-design classes that offered a lot of competition. It's probably an enormous rationalization, but I don't think I could have made a better choice. This beloved square boat and the people who listen to it slam through waves have become my tribe. To quote the immortal words of Stuart Nickerson, "I LOVE THIS CLASS." In the intervening years, I have owned Lightnings 13686, 14530, 14740, 15260 and am currently sailing 15480. I have been active on the Lightning Governing Board virtually non-stop since being elected Secretary in 1995. I was Class President in 1996 and 1997. It is a joy to serve in every capacity. And I particularly thank my long-time teammate Jared Drake for rigging or derigging our boat at every big regatta for the last twenty years while I was listening to myself talk in some meeting.

The last two years I have been elected the 5th "At Large" or "Fifth Wheel" member of the Executive Committee. I'm here to tell you that today that the Lightning Class is operated in a manner we would not have recognized in 1997. There is not a week when we don't have at least two Skype calls among the headquarters and members of the Executive Committee, and I'd say we average thirty emails between us a week. There is an incredible amount of activity that goes on, which is largely why our hard-chined beauty is still a vital class.

In 1995, I was living in a small apartment in Chicago with two cats and a pile of rolled up sails. I bought a new truck in order to drive thirteen hours to Thunder Bay for the Canadian Open. I didn't own a TV. Today, I live with my wife Julie and our two kids with a bunch of furniture and flat screens and Legos and American Girl Dolls. The sails are now out in the attic of the garage. That truck is still out there too. It has 255,000+ miles on it. I'm planning to drive it thirteen hours to Thunder Bay this summer for the Canadian Open. The more things change, the more some things are gonna stay the same.

Laura Jeffers – Executive Secretary

I had just returned from my first sail ever on a Cal 21 and thought that was the coolest thing ever—until I walked up the dock.
