NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority is Lake Lanier Lightning Fleet 348.
- 1.2 The regatta is governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2017-2020), the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the International Lightning Class (ILCA), this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments.
- 1.3 RRS 44.2 shall apply, except that when a boat has her spinnaker drawing at the time of the breach, her penalty shall be a one-turn penalty with the head of her spinnaker below the gooseneck from the time she passes head -to-wind until she is on a downwind course.
- 1.4 Rule 63.7 shall be replaced by – If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the Sailing Instruction shall apply. This changes RRS 63.7.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the ILCA that conform to class rules.
- 2.2 The skipper and crew must be members of the ILCA.
- 2.3 All boats must hold a valid measurement certificate.
- 2.4 Safety equipment may be inspected.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing registration any time prior to 1000 Saturday, June 1.

3. FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$120.00 USD per boat for registration forms received by Friday, May 24. The entry fee for forms received after May 24 is \$140.00 USD. Check or Cash payments will be accepted onsite to complete registration.
- 3.2 3 Dinners are included in each boat fee along with Breakfast each morning. Extra Dinners are \$20.00 per Adult. \$10.00 per Child 10 & under.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SELD Championship Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6. VENUE

Lake Lanier (Generally to the west of LLSC and may include waters outside of the bay dependent on wind direction)

7. COURSES

The courses will be Windward-Leeward, approximately 45-60 minutes in duration.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The scoring system will be the Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A and as modified herein.
- 8.2 Race Committee will attempt to run as many races as practical. One race may constitute a series.
- 8.3 The boat's score shall be the total of her races scores.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the Skippers and Crews placing first through third places.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Sailing Instructions will change RRS 41 to permit the use of hand-held VHF radios to receive communications from the Race Committee (RC) on a predetermined channel. The RC intends to use VHF radio to identify OCS (On the Course Side of the starting line) after starts and to communicate with the Fleet on the water. Failure to receive a hail, for a hail to be made or the order of hails shall not be grounds for granting redress.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Racing Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority and Lake Lanier Sailing Club and its Board of Governors and members will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
