Notice of Race

1 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and prescriptions of US Sailing.
- 1.2 The ILCA Constitution and By-Laws in regard to sanctioned events except where changed here or in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 If the spinnaker is drawing at the time of an infringement and if the spinnaker is subsequently reset, there shall be a one-turn penalty instead of a two-turn. (this changes RRS 44.2)
- 1.4 VHF radios will be allowed for communication between boats and the Race Committee as per ILCA By-Laws Article VIII 5.b.4 .a. The Race Committee requests and encourages the use of VHF Radios as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 There shall be 1 exclusion if 5 races are completed. This changes RRS A2.

2 Advertising

2.1 ISAF Regulation 20 will apply.

3 Eligibility

- 3.1 The Champagne Regatta is open to boats of the Lightning Class that conform to the class rules.
- 3.2 The Classic Boat Regatta is open to all Classic Boats as defined by any Lightning built of wood or a glass boat older than the year 1976 or hull number 12500, other boats may be admitted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

3.3 All boats shall have all necessary safety equipment as specified in Appendix S

4 Registration

4.1 Registration may be made in person at KYC and will take place Saturday, September 12, 8:00-11:00 AM

5 Fees

- 5.1 \$75.00 per boat including skipper and crew. This includes all regatta functions.
- 5.2 Additional dinner tickets will be available for purchase.

6 Schedule

Friday September 11

Boat arrival and setup after 5 pm.

Tent camping / setup is available on site after 5 pm for Friday and Saturday evening at the Yacht Club free of charge. Bathrooms and showers available.

7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 Sailing Instructions shall be available at registration.

8 Venue

8.1 This regatta shall be held at the Keuka Yacht Club and the waters of Keuka Lake.

9 Courses

9.1 Drop mark, Windward Leeward or Triangle.

10 Scoring

- 10.1 Appendix A except that if 5 races are sailed there shall be 1 exclusion. This changes RRS Appendix A.
- 11 Penalties
 - 11.1 RRS 44.2 may be changes and described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 12 Propulsion
 - 12.1 RRS 42.3 may be changed and described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 13 Prizes
 - 13.1 Champagne Regatta
 - 13.1.1 Trophies for overall top 3 finishing boats and crew
 - 13.2 Classic Boat Regatta
 - 13.2.1 Trophies for overall top 2 finishing boats, plus additional award for top finishing wooden mast boat.
- 14 Storage and Launching
 - 14.1 Boat storage will be made available at the Keuka Yacht Club on the waterfront blacktop area. Skippers will be permitted to deposit their boats by vehicle but must remove vehicles from the waterfront parking area. Vehicle parking may be found opposite of the Keuka Yacht Club entrance as well as on the second level parking area. Keuka Yacht Club is equipped with 2 boat hoists and a boat ramp to be used as need by the visiting sailors.
- 15 Radio Communications
 - 15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
 - 15.2 The Race Committee may make race announcements on VHF radio on Channel 68 as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 16 Support Boats
 - 16.1 Detailed instructions regarding support boats shall be in the Sailing Instructions

17 Waiver of liability

17.1 All competitors shall sign a waiver of liability at time of registration for loss, damage or injury to persons or property incurred in connection with this event or on the property of KYC and to release KYC, the Lightning Class, any sponsors of the event, and their members, officers, governors, employees, agents and sponsors from any liability for any such loss, damage, or injury. All competitors under the age of 18 shall have parental permission.

18 NY State and KYC pandemic procedures

- 18.1 Specific Covid protocols in place at the time of the regatta must be adhered to at all times while on the KYC premises. Protocol, procedures and any NY State required questionnaires will be provided to all participants prior in the registration packet.
- 18.2 If you have traveled from within one of the "designated quarantined states" with significant Covid community spread, you must quarantine when you enter New York for 14 days from the last travel within such designated state, provided on the date you enter into New York State that such state met the criteria for requiring such quarantine. Appendix S

Specification (Bylaws ART VIII # 5): A boat must carry ground tackle of serviceable character for the locality, three life preservers, a compass, minimum one gallon bucket, throw-able life preserver with attached whistle, and a paddle as approved by the Race Committee. In absence of special conditions, the ground tackle shall be a fluke-type anchor weighing not less than 4 pounds (1.8 kg) with 50 feet of line attached. Variation may be made only by specific written permission from the Chief Measurer when local conditions dictate. A boat must be fitted with a centerboard preventer.
